

LESSONS LEARNED



- Mountain municipalities are capable of handling sustainable construction, but they need help (Local authority Service Package)
- Participation solves problems before they occur
- Tradesmen need training in the use of ecological materials
- Finance products targeted at the specifities of NZEB need to be developed

CONCLUSIONS I



- Life Cycle Cost Analysis
 - Still have too little economic consideration
 - Can convince decision makers to implement the NZEB-Standard
- Regional economic effects
 - Integrate to calculations
- Standardise calculation methods where possible (grey energy)
